## About the plastic clinic

Plastic surgery is broad specialty which includes:

- Hand trauma
- Breast reconstruction
- Facial trauma
- Surgical skin conditions
- Cosmetic surgery
- Skin cancer including melanoma

Patients are referred to the plastics clinic following a recent visit to the MSH Emergency Department following surgery at the hospital or from their family doctor.

## Services include:

- Diagnostic imaging
- Occupational therapy and splinting
- Hand exercise instruction by our hand physiotherapist
- Casting
- Wound care
- Injections

## During your appointment...

You may be seen by other professionals as part of your healthcare team, including:

- Plastic surgeons
- Nurses
- Physiotherapists
- Occupational therapists
- Orthopaedic technologists
- X-ray technologists
- Secretarial staff
- Volunteers

Due to the very high volume of patients seen at this clinic and the complexity of each appointment please prepare for a one to two hour visit.

## What to bring to your appointment

- OHIP card
- Any x-rays (films or CDs not taken at MSH)
- Copies of any labs/tests (given to you by your doctor)
- Debit or credit card
- Translator if needed

## How to book an appointment:

**Emergency Department (ED) referrals:** an appointment will be scheduled prior to being discharged from the ED.

**Post-operative referrals:** patients will receive an appointment after your surgery before going home by the nurse.

**Community referrals:** once the referral has been reviewed by the surgeon you will receive a call from the plastic clinic secretary with your appointment information.

### NOTE:

- All patients must have a referral and an appointment to be seen in the plastic clinic.
- The plastic clinic is a busy clinic with a high volume of calls. Patients may experience difficulties in reaching the secretary. Your patience is appreciated. The secretary will return messages in a timely manner.
